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Abdullah Gül University's Disability Accommodation Policy ensures that all students with disabilities have equal access to educational opportunities, programs, and services. This policy outlines the procedures for requesting and implementing accommodations to create an inclusive and accessible learning environment within the campus. This policy applies to all students with disabilities enrolled in academic programs, courses, and activities offered by Abdullah Gül University.

Definition of Disability: A physical, sensory, cognitive, or mental impairment substantially limits one or more major life activities. Students who require accommodations should contact the AGU Student Affairs as early as possible, preferably before the start of the academic term. AGU trains faculty and staff on disability awareness, accommodation procedures, and creating an inclusive learning environment.

This policy will be reviewed periodically and updated to ensure its effectiveness and compliance with applicable laws and regulations. AGU is committed to providing equal access and opportunities for all students. This policy reflects our dedication to creating an inclusive and accessible educational environment for individuals with disabilities.
