

Public Disclosure and Accountability Principles Document

Objective

This document has been prepared to explain the principles, rules and methods adopted by the unit on public information and accountability and to demonstrate the effectiveness of the related activities.

Principles

- **Transparency:** All information sharing processes are conducted in an open, understandable and accessible manner.
- **Accessibility:** Public announcements and reports are shared on platforms accessible to everyone.
- **Timely Disclosure:** Disclosure materials and announcements are regularly updated.
- **Accountability:** The Unit fulfills its accountability obligations by regularly reporting on its activities.
- **Data Security:** The unit collects the information needed for its activities through the systems secured by the university and ensures that they are stored on platforms controlled by the university.

Methods Used

- **Website:** Unit activities, announcements and reports are regularly published on the official website, which is open to public access.
- **Platforms Under the Control of the University:** The unit securely collects the data it needs through the university's KVYS system and stores it on the AGU Depo.
- **Annual Reporting:** A detailed report on the activities carried out within the scope of accountability obligations is prepared and shared with the public every year.
- **Events and Meetings:** Seminars, trainings, information meetings and workshops are organized to inform stakeholders.
- **Social Media:** Up-to-date information and announcements about the unit's activities are shared through social media accounts.
